

## Recommendation 30

for noise mitigation south of DCA

South of Airport Subcommittee October 23, 2025

## **Overview**

- **Objective:** Noise mitigation for communities south of Reagan National Airport (DCA), along the south flow departure and the north flow arrival flight paths
- South of Airport (SoA) Study: The SoA Subcommittee supported technically by Vianair in consultation with the FAA conducted 11 meetings to develop recommendations for noise mitigation
  - Support for Vianair was provided by Alexandria, Fairfax County and Prince Georges County
- **Result:** Six specific recommendations were developed that met the Design Philosophy. The SoA Subcommittee voted unanimous support
- Benefits:
  - For communities: tangible noise relief and reduced overflights
  - For air traffic control and the airport: increased efficiency and operational flexibility
  - For airlines: reduced track miles and more efficient procedures

## Recommendations

- Implementation of Reduced Divergence Departures from Runway 19 with improvements in flight paths from Runway 15, to move aircraft further away from Alexandria
  - Also ensures compliance with current criteria for more safe and efficient operations
- Split westbound departure, moving southwest directed flights over the river
- Modify north flow arrivals to raise the altitude at KATRN to 3,000 feet and provide alternate points to intercept the final approach course
- Move CAPSS south flow arrivals slightly to east to allow for more rapid climb during south flow departures
- Move TRUPS/FRDMM STARs to the southwest to reduce noise during north flow operations
- Implement Noise Abatement Departure Procedure (NADP-1), which could provide meaningful noise relief to communities near the airport
